HOW IT WORKS

PRIOR TO THE SESSION:

A link to the "Zoom" session will be sent to the booking teacher in advance to be forwarded on to all students attending the session. You will also receive a copy of our 'Shakespeare Without Tears: Webinar Study Guide' to assist with further study and discussion of the play.

DURING THE SESSION:

The booking teacher will be admitted to the Zoom session 5 minutes prior to the students. This is an opportunity to discuss any final queries and be introduced to the actors presenting the session.

The first part of the webinar is an opportunity for the students to witness live performances of text, while being given an overview of the plot of the play. As the session progresses the cohort will be split in to break out rooms where they can ask questions and share their ideas with their guests.
