A classic fairy tale that shows all the ways in which being yourself is the best thing you can be.

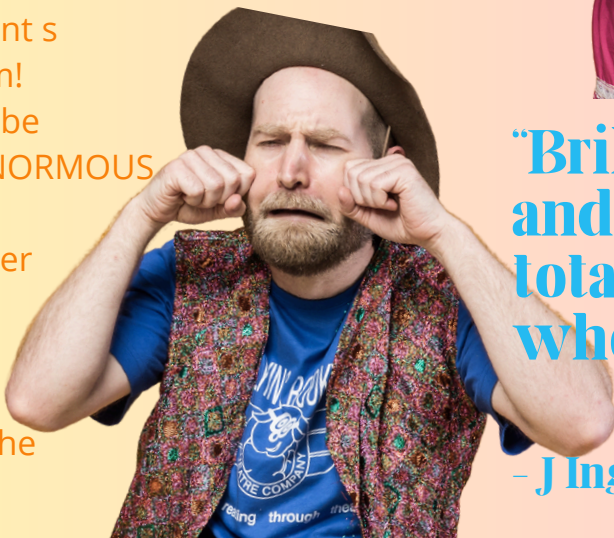
The Gigantic Turnip
